

COMPOSITE DECKING:

Composite decking is great use of recyclable products like cardboard, plastic, wood and other materials. It's very structurally sound and will outlast wood but like everything else it needs to be cleaned and cleaning composite decking can be a hard to solve project.

With all cleaning projects there are 3 components needed to be successful:

- 1. Knowledge
- 2. Equipment
- 3. Product

Tools Needed:

- Gallon (s) of Wash Safe Spray & Clean (see coverage chart)
- 2. Garden style pump sprayer
- Goggles
- 4. Gloves
- Scrub Brush (optional)
- Pressure Washer (optional)

Dilution Ratio:

(chart based on visibility of mold stains)

Extremely Visible = Straight

Very Visible = 1:1

Visible Stains = 2:1

Just Became Visible = 3:1

Routine Cleaning = 4:1



Coverage:

To figure out how much Spray & Clean you will need figure that each gallon of diluted Spray & Clean will clean 250 sq. ft. of decking but the product may be diluted in different ratios depending on the condition, age, time of last cleaning and brand of your decking. In extreme cases Spray & Clean should be used straight without dilution. For routine (maintenance type) cleaning Spray & Clean should be diluted 4:1 (4 parts water 1 part Spray & Clean, in that ratio 1 gallon of Spray & Clean would make 5 gallons of cleaning solution.

Cleaning Instructions:

After deciding on the dilution ratio mix Spray & Clean with water (warm/hot if possible) and put in a garden style pump sprayer, saturate the stained decking allowing the product to be absorbed by

the decking, stains will start to disappear on contact, when completed rinse the deck off with water, a pressure washer and/or a scrub brush will assist in the cleaning process, for stubborn stains reapply, soak deck for 2 hours or overnight if needed and rinse as directed.
